The City Council of the City of Ozark, Alabama, met in Regular Session in the Council Chamber of the Municipal Complex at 5:30 P.M. on Tuesday, July 5, 2022. Upon roll call the following members were present:

The Council having read the minutes from the Regular Council Meeting held on June 21, 2022 President Pro Tem Jackson asked the wishes of the Council. Councilmember Harlow made a motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Council Meeting held on June 21, 2022, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Enfinger. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.
